The Bruichladdich Twenty 1st Edition was voted the best single malt in a blind tasting of 3,000 malts in the Scottish Field 2002 Merchants' Challenge.

The 2nd Edition has generated more press coverage and Industry debate than any other Bruichladdich whisky owing to its unique character, imaginative *affinage* - and unintentional rosé colour.

This specially created cuvée is no marketing wheeze – at over £75.00 per bottle with 20 years maturation – this is *far* from frivolous.

- ⦿ Second Edition stocks will be released exclusively on allocation
- ⦿ Bottles and tins clearly state "2nd Edition" on the front of the bottle – but are not individually numbered
- ⦿ Distillery bottled at 46% strength using Islay's legendary spring water, non chill-filtered, and caramel free – for a fuller flavour

### Tasting Note

Sweet malt, creamy toffee, and vanilla combine with a top layer of sweet berry and plum fruit, and herb, peppercorn and exotic truffle spicy rare *Mourvedre* wine to create Bruichladdich's most complex and exciting whisky ever.

### Wine Match

Reminds me of a serious, opulent, Chardonnay; but this time, more Batard than Chevalier Montrachet; more Grgich than Calera.
